## McIntyre Report To MAKE GOOD SHOWING

R. E. Komerer in his latest letter says:

"The forthcoming quarterly statement of the McIntyre Company will embody results and information which cannot be proved more gratifying to shareholders. This statement will show a total production, including Jupiter ore treated, of approximately 25,000 tons while the production, profit of the McIntyre itself will appear as an increase of some \$15,000 or \$18,000 over the previous quarter. There has been a steady growth in the profits of the McIntyre Company during the past year, the production in the final quarter of last year was \$75,455, in the first quarter of this year \$97,125 and in the quarter ending June 30, 1916, the quarter just ended, it is stated above, show approximately \$118,000, so that the production of the company is almost double that of a year ago.

Underground conditions of the property continue to be most satisfactory. The Boundary vein which is being worked on the 1,000-foot level, is holding steadily in the slope at a width of about 20 feet of ore which runs at something better than \$14.50 per ton. On the 700-foot level, where the company has two ore bodies, the vein is still maintaining both width and values; the values in one case reached \$18.00 per ton, in the other case at about \$15.00. There is also a new vein on the 800-foot level which was encountered from the No. 4 shaft, and which is running steadily at a value of about \$7.00 to the ton.

Deal Gives It Fifteen New Branches in Quebec and One in Ontario.

The taking over of the Quebec Bank gives the Royal Bank 15 new branches in Quebec and one in Ontario, and in Saskatchewan and two in Alberta. Twenty-nine other branches, where the Royal is already represented, will most of them be wiped out.
