One fact places all alcoholic stimulants at a wide distance from the common necessaries of life, those articles which are designed for our use have no natural tendency to lead to sinful indulgence. I cat a certain quantity of food, and drink a certain quantity of water, or milk, or any other wholesome liquid to-day, and there is no desire for an increased quantity, to-morrow; but if I partake of intoxicating liquors, a craving may be originated which gains strength day by day, and the demands of which keep pace with its growth. Here, then, between the bounties of a merciful God, and the products of man's perverted ingenuity there is a wide distinction.
