\$3000 of this amount will be invested in the course of a few days.

I append to this account also a list of the present investments amounting to \$52,800, and yielding interest amounting to \$3,616 per annum.

Of the above amount, the sum of \$10,560, is on account of local endowments not belonging to the Sustentation fund.

No. 4 is the Interest Account of the Sustentation fund showing a balance to its credit of \$989.21. (See page 689.)

Excess of payments over receipts,

The receipts and expenses will not vary, as far as it is possible to form an estimate, if the grants to Missions are unaltered during the current year, and if so, there will probably be a balance against the Mission fund on 1st June 1876 of upwards of \$2,000.

The amount received both from the City and Country has been less than in the previous year.

The interest from the Sustentation fund during the current year will probably be about \$3,500.

It seems, however, to be clear that the income of the Mission fund is not increasing, and that the expenditure is getting larger.
