

The Annual Meeting of the *City of Toronto Auxiliary Bible Society* was held in St. Andrews Church, the 10th of February, 1834.

The Honorable JOHN H. DUNN, PRESIDENT, in the Chair.

The meeting having been opened with Prayer, by the Rev. WM. RINTOUL, and the Report of the Committee read, by one of the Secretaries, the following Resolutions were unanimously adopted:

1st. Moved by Rev. J. RICHARDSON, seconded by Mr. T. PARSONS,—“That the Report now read be adopted and printed, under the direction of the Committee.”

2nd. Moved by the Rev. Dr. HARRIS, seconded by the Rev. Mr. SUTCLIFF,—“That this Society acknowledge with gratitude the continued support and co-operation of the Parent Society, and that our grateful thanks be tendered to the Committee of the Parent Institution for their Christian liberality.”

3rd. Moved by the Rev. T. F. CALDICOTT, seconded by Capt. PHILLIPPS,—“That this meeting learn with pleasure, the progress that has been made in the translation of the Scriptures into the Chippewa language,—and that its cordial thanks be given to those who have contributed to it, and hope that the Committee will be enabled to continue the work to its full accomplishment.”

4th. Moved by the Rev. W. RINTOUL, seconded by the Rev. A. STEWART,—“That this meeting gratefully acknowledge the aid which it has received from several of its Auxiliaries, especially the Ladies' Bible Association, during the past year, and that recognizing the formation of local societies throughout the Province, as indispensable to the full supply of the population with the word of life, it recommends the Committee for the ensuing year, particularly to attend to the formation of Auxiliaries.”

5th. Moved by Mr. J. FENTON, seconded by PETER PATERSON, Esq.—“That the cordial thanks of this meeting be given to His Excellency Sir JOHN COLBORN, &c. &c. for his continued patronage.”

6th. Moved by the Rev. E. RYERSON, seconded by JAMES H. PRICE, Esq.—“That the thanks of this meeting be given to the Honorable JOHN HENRY DUNN, President, for his unwearied attention to the affairs of this Society.”

7th. Moved by the Rev. Mr. PARTINGTON, seconded by the Rev. J. RICHARDSON, Secretaries, and Committee for their services during the past year.”

8th. Moved by the Rev. WM. RINTOUL, seconded by the Rev. Dr. HARRIS,—“That the Fifth Rule of the Society be altered as follows:—That the business of the Society shall be conducted by a President, Vice-Presidents, a Treasurer, Secretaries, and a Committee consisting of fifteen other Members, ten of whom may be re-elected, five to form a quorum—and that all ministers of the Gospel, who are members of the Society, shall be entitled to a seat and vote with the Committee.”

9th. Moved by the Rev. J. HARRIS, seconded by the Rev. A. Stewart,—“That the following persons compose the Committee for the ensuing year, with power to fill vacancies if necessary.”—(See List of Committee.)

The meeting was concluded with Prayer by the Rev. F. RYERSON.
