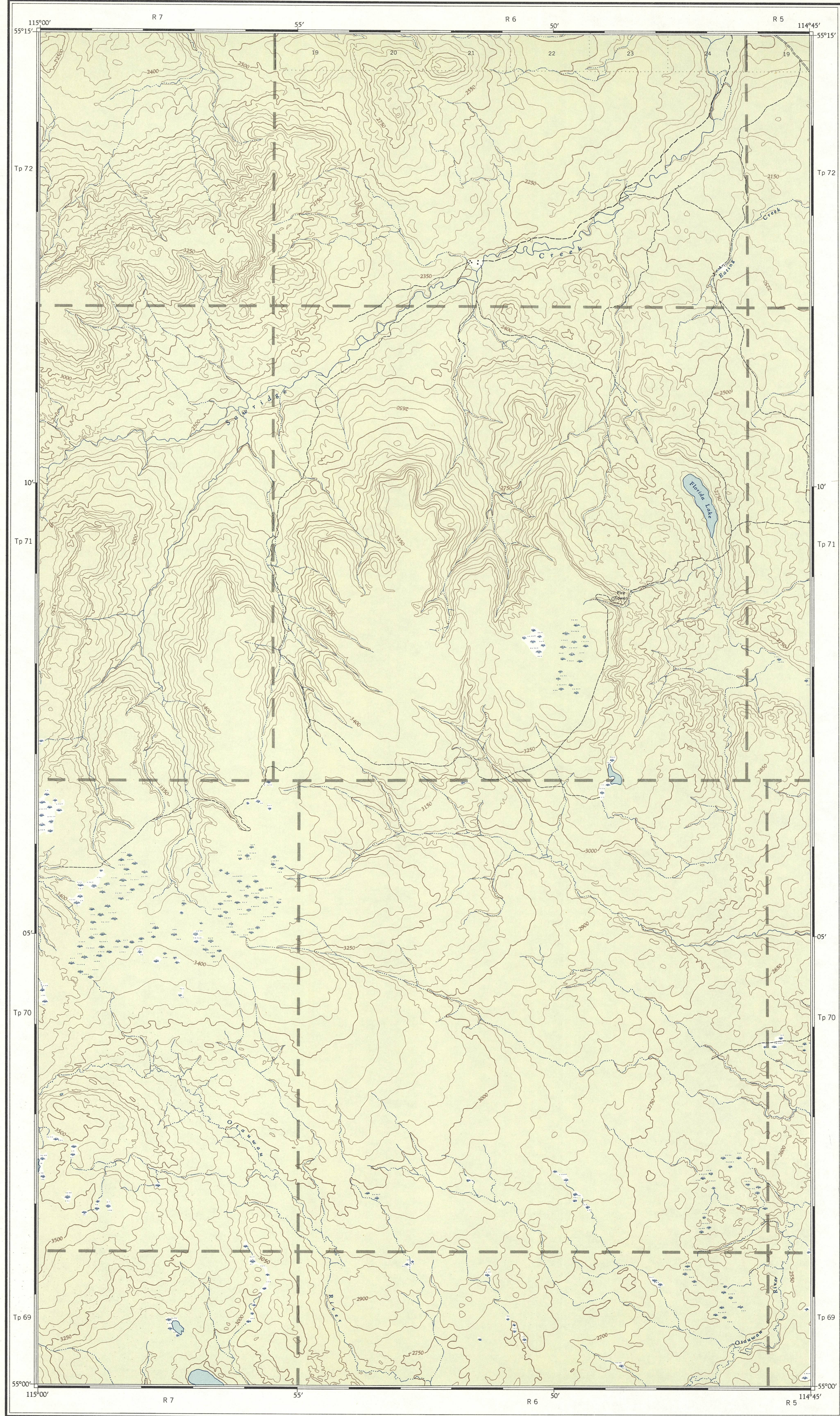




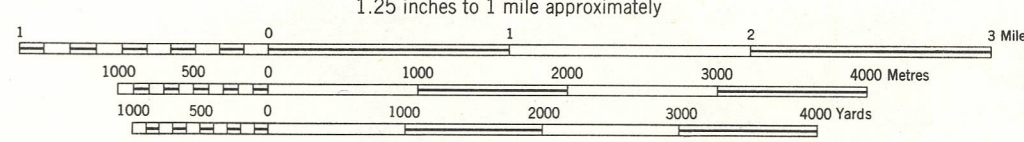

North American Datum 1927

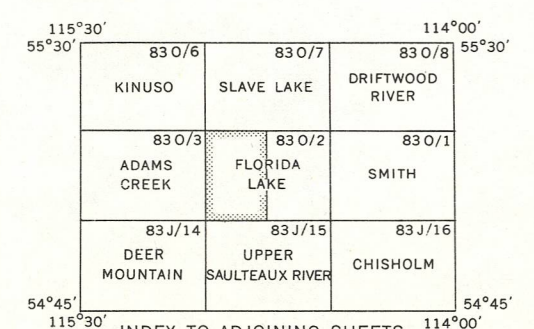
