By instructions of the Hon. Minister of Agriculture a distribution of superior sorts of grain and potatoes will be made during the coming winter and spring to Canadian farmers. The samples for general distribution will consist of spring wheat (No. 1) white oats (4 lbs.), barley (5 lbs.) and field peas (5 lbs.). These will be sent free of charge to the most thoughtful and successful potato growers in Ontario and Quebec. All samples will be sent free, by mail.

SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS... Any person who has a lease of a family or any man over 18 years old, may be interested in the regulations of the Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The regulations are as follows: Entry by proxy may be made at any agency of the Department of the Interior. A homesteader may live within the limits of his homestead for at least six months before he is entitled to a certificate of title. A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption certificate may purchase a homestead in certain districts. Price \$100 per acre. Dues—Must reside upon the homestead or pre-emption six months in each year.
