

WORLD'S DRY CONGRESS WILL MEET AT ONCE

Washington, Sept. 21.—The fifteenth International Congress Against Alcoholism will open tomorrow for a six-day session with delegates from most parts of the world present. Originally, the Congress was to have assembled in 1916, but having been postponed year by year because of the war the present meeting will be the first since that at Milan, Italy, in 1913. Speakers from 15 foreign countries are on the program. Those from the United States will include William J. Bryan, Attorney-General Palmer and Secretary Daniels, who will discuss phases of national prohibition. In addition to the speeches, the Congress will stage a pageant illustrating the anti-liquor movement in this country. An exhibit also will be held of materials and methods used in the world campaign against liquor, and of the development in the manufacture and sale of soft drinks.

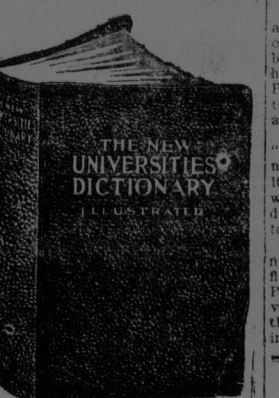

BISHOP CONDEMNS MODERN STYLES

Not to be Used to "Exhibit Nakedness" He Warns His People.

San Juan, Sept. 21.—Present styles and the newer dances are severely criticized as immodest and degrading by the Rt. Rev. William A. Jones, Bishop of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Porto Rico, who has issued a warning to both priests and parishioners against their demoralizing influences. Certain of the modern dances are "brothels to shame and in reality are nothing more than a bait to sensuality." In the opinion of the Bishop, while the style of the day in women's dresses, he warns, should not be used to "exhibit nakedness." Priests are advised that they may not organize dances for church benefit, according to instructions from the Pope, while they may not attend festivities organized by lay members of their congregations where dancing is indulged in.
