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RULES

FOR THE

CHARITABLE COMMITTEE

OF

ST. GEORGE'S SOCIETY,
QUEBEC.

I. The Committee shall appoint its own Chairman and Secretary.

II. In accordance with the rules of the Society, the attention of the Charitable Committee, shall be directed solely to persons of English and Welch extraction, not otherwise provided for.

III. Monthly meetings of the Committee shall be held on the first Friday in every month, at three o'clock, P. M. at the Albion Hotel.

IV. At each Monthly meeting, an account in writing, of the state of the charitable fund, as correct as circumstances will admit of, shall be laid before the Committee, by the Treasurer.

V. On the application of any two members of the Committee, Special Meetings shall be called by the Chairman, or of himself, if he should deem it expedient.

VI. At all meetings, three members, one of whom shall be the Chairman or Treasurer, shall form a quorum.
