*Section 13.*—And be it further ordered, That duty shall be charged on all goods *ex warehouse* on the gauge or weight, when taken out for home consumption, *per prime entry*, without any deduction or allowance whatever for loss which may have arisen from natural causes or otherwise. Goods for

*Section 14.*—And be it further ordered, That there shall be deducted from the gross weight of goods the tare according to the original invoice, the correctness of the invoice to be declared before the Collector, and in the absence of such invoice, or the omission of tare in the invoice, the medium tare shall be ascertained by weighing a few packages of the importation, and adopting the result as the standard for the whole. Allowance to

*Section 15.*—And be it further ordered; That Collectors of Customs shall in all cases where the same is practicable, cause goods upon which the duty has been paid to be marked or branded with the initial letters of the Port, month or day of the month, and the year, when such goods have been entered for duty.
