VIII. And be it enacted, That the said <sup>Power to
Company to
explore cer-
tain tract of
country.</sup>
Company shall have full power and authority
to explore the country lying between the said
10 point known as Card's Corner, in the said
Township of Guelph, by way of the said
Village of Ellora to the Township line of the
said Township of Peel, in a direction towards
the mouth of the said River Saugeen as
15 aforesaid, and to designate and establish, and
it shall be lawful for the said Company to
take, appropriate, have and hold to and for
the use of them and their successors, the re-
quisite lands upon the line, and within the
20 limits of the said road hereby authorised to be
constructed : and for the purposes aforesaid,
the said Company and their agents, servants
and workmen are hereby authorised and em-
powered to enter into and upon the lands and
25 grounds of and belonging to the Queen's
Majesty, Her Heirs or Successors, or any
person or persons, body or bodies corporate
or politic.

IX. And be it enacted, That whenever the <sup>Trees and un-
derwood to be
cut down 100
feet on each
side of road,
when it passes
through a
wood.</sup>
30 said road passes through or by any wood or
standing timber, the said Company may cause
the trees and underwood to be cut down for
the space of one hundred feet on each side of
the said road, leaving the said trees and under-
35 wood when so cut down, but without paying
any indemnity to the proprietor or occupier
of the land, and for this purpose the said
Company may enter upon such land (doing
no further or unnecessary damage) without
40 any previous notice or leave from such pro-
prietor or occupier.
