plead and be impleaded in its name; and generally the said Corporation shall enjoy all rights and privileges necessary to the due administration of all its property.

Application of property.

III. All property at any time held by the Corporation, as well as the revenues arising therefrom, shall be appropriated and applied solely to the advancement of education and to the other charitable works performed, in accordance with the rules of their Order, by the said Dames de Jésus-Marie, and to the construction, repair, or renting of the buildings requisite for the purposes of the Corporation, as well for the benefit of the Mother-house instituted by the said Dames Religiouses de Jésus-Marie at St. Joseph de la Pointe Lévis, as for the other institutions subordinate to the said Mother-house, which have already been established or may hereafter be established in other Parishes in this Province.

Yearly returns to the Governor. IV. The said Corporation shall furnish to the Governor General, in the month of January of each year, a statement shewing the amount of real and other property held by the said Corporation in virtue of the provisions of this Act, and the revenue arising therefrom, together with the number of members of the Corporation, the number of teachers and pupils, and a statement of the course of studies.

V. This Act shall be deemed a Public A ct.
