Expedition shall be enrolled, (insinué) and to every such memorial or abstract and certificate so endorsed, shall set and subscribe his proper signature, and every such memorial or abstract and certificate so endorsed, shall be deemed and adjudged to be an Acte authentique and a Copy thereof duly certified to be such by such Register, or his successor in office, shall be received and allowed as evidence in all Courts and in all respects as Copies of other Actes authentiques are now received and allowed, and of every such memorial or abstract and certificate, such Register shall then and there deliver a certified Copy to the person by whom such Copy or Expedition shall be so enrolled (insinué) and in a Book to be by him annually kept for that purpose, whereof each page shall be paraphaed by two of the Judges of the Court of King's Bench of and for the Distriet in which such Register shall act, shall then and there enter and insert an exact duplicate of such memorial or abstract and certificate, and to such duplicate so entered and inserted in such Book, shall also then and there set and subscribe his proper signature, and on the 31st day of December in each year, such Book containing the duplicates of such memorials or abstracts and certificates so paraphaed and so subscribed, shall by such Register be deposited of record in the office of the Secretary of this Province, and in the case of loss or destruction by fire or other accident of any original memorial or abstract or certificate in the office of any such Register, a Copy of such duplicate thereof so deposited in the office of the Secretary of this Province, and duly certified to be such by such Secretary or his successor in office, shall in like manner be received and allowed as evidence in all Courts, and in all respects as a copy of such original Memorial, or Abstract and Certificate duly certified by such Register, would, (if such original Certificate had not been so lost or otherwise destroyed) by virtue of this Act, have been received and allowed.

IX. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every Register shall keep an Alphabetical Index of all Actes which by him shall be enrolled, (insinués) according to the provisions of this Act, with reference to the number of each Acte, to the parties thereunto and as far as may be practicable to the property thereby conveyed, or by way of Mortgage or Hypotheque, or otherwise affected; and such Register, from time to time, shall cause to be bound in volumes all Actes which by him enrolled, (insinué) in numerical shall be order and succession according to the numbers by him thereon indorsed in obedience to the directions of this Act, and therein upon the request of any person or persons and upon payment of the fees by this Act directed, shall diligently search for any Acte or Actes therein enrolled or supposed to be enrolled,
