Preamble.

WHEREAS the Laws herein-after mentioned have, by Experience, been found useful and beneficial, and it is expedient that the same should be further continued; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That so much of an Act made in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to amend and render more effectual the several Laws now in Force for encouraging the Fisheries carried on at Newfoundland and Parts adjacent, from Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions in Europe; and for granting Bounties for a limited Time, on certain Terms and Conditions*, as relates to the Bounties thereby granted, which was to continue in Force for the Term of Ten Years, from the First Day of *January* One thousand seven hundred and eighty-seven; and which was revived and further continued by Three Acts made in the Thirty-seventh, Thirty-ninth, and Thirty-ninth and Fortieth Years of the Reign of His present Majesty, until the First Day of *January* One thousand eight hundred and two, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued until the First Day of *January* One thousand eight hundred and three.

So much of 26 Geo. III, Cap. 26, for encouraging the Newfoundland Fisheries, etc. as relates to Bounties, continued till Jan. 1, 1803.

26 Geo. III, Cap. 41, for Encouragement of the Greenland Seas Fisheries, &c. and so much of 29 Geo. III, Cap. 53, as relates to those Fisheries, continued till Dec. 25, 1802.

II. And be it further enacted, That an Act made in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for the further Support and Encouragement of the Fisheries carried on in the Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights*, which was to be in Force for Five Years, from the Twenty-fifth Day of *December* One thousand seven hundred and eighty-six, and also so much of an Act made in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for further encouraging and regulating the Newfoundland, Greenland, and Southern Whale Fisheries*, as relates to the Fisheries carried on in the *Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights*, which, by an Act made in the Thirty-
