Plan full-day classes for mentally retarded ered and made compatible

Full-day classes for some students will be imple-mented at Red Oaks and Parkholme Schools for the Mentally Retarded.

Bill Quance, special services supervisor for the Peel County Board of Education, told board trustees last Tuesday he thought full-day classes would help speed up the return rate of elementary to students schools.

Quance received Mr. permission from the board to extend classes to a full day at last Tuesday's regular meeting of the board. THREE MONTHS

The program will be in effect for the next three months and the results of the trial period will be studied and presented to the board.

Presently there are four students at Parkholme and eight at Red Oaks who will be started on the full-day system

Since 1968 there have been four students from Parkholme and 10 students from Red Oaks who have reentered elementary school.

Mr. Quance was asked by Trustee John Hart if a three month trial would be sufficient to judge the outcome of the classes

Mr. Hart was told that doubling the amount of schooling from the present half day would help speed up learning Mr. Quance said the students would profit.

Trustee Rudy Bos said the idea was "a very progressive step and I am sure the Department of Education will be very interested in what happens.
