I beg to advise that Mr.Allan McPherson the timber licensee for part of the Whitefish Lake Reserve (Louisa Twp.) has submitted sworn culler returns showing the kinds and quantities of timber cut last season, and an account has been prepared, which is enclosed herewith showing the amount of dues payable thereon.

The Department desires to draw your attention to the fact that the culler returns indicate that most of the logs were cut from very small timber (particularly the hardwood varieties) and as this license specifies a minimum diameter of 10 inches it is considered that a large proportion of the timber has been cut from trees under-size.

I have therefore to request you to make inquiry into this matter, before sending the enclosed account with a request for payment.
