Description for Patent Surrender.

All that tract of land situate near Boat Harbour Pictou, N.S. containing by admeasurement 78.90 acres, being the land recently purchased by the Department of Indian Affairs from Captain John Foster for the use of the Indians of the Fishers Grant Indian Reserves. The said lot is bounded on the North-east by the land of Campbell Sproull and on the North-west by the rear line of the Fishers Grant lots and on the South-west by the land of Charles Fraser; as shown on a plan of survey dated 6th Sept. 1910 made by Albert McKean, P.L.S. and of record in the Department of Indian Affairs under No. 370133.
