Dear Sir:-

The Hamilton Conference of The Methodist Church Of Canada, meeting at Niagara Falls last week, passed a resolution re Church Union, a copy of which I have been instructed to forward to you. You will find this copy enclosed.

The territory of the Hamilton Conference extends from Niagara Falls on the South up into the Bruce Peninsula on the North. It comprises two hundred stations and circuits. The conference gathering is composed of 250 ministers, and an equal number of laymen, representing a membership of over 60,000, and a larger constituency of adherents. This body passed the resolution re Church Union unanimously with a standing vote.
