Representations have been made to the Department that it is desired to have a tract of land set apart as an Indian reserve for the Indians of Beaver Lake North, near Lac La Biche. I shall feel obliged if you will be good enough to take up this question, and give me your views thereon.

It appears that these Indians have lived on the shores of the lake as far back as they can remember, and fishing in the said Lake is their chief means of subsistence.
