Ottawa, 3rd. April, 1915.

The Indian Agent it Selkirk reports that the Indians of Fort Alexander Band request to be furnished with seed wheat and he states that one hundred bushels are required.

Kindly report at once on this application stating whether the indians have the land prepared and they have not the means of purchasing seed themselves.

Can seed wheat be purchased in the vicinity of the Reserve and, if so, at what price? The Department was not aware that these Indians were raising wheat.
