Referring to your letter of the 22nd instant, I beg to state that the 3000 gun caps purchased by you from the Hudson's Bay Company should be dealt with as supplementary to their contract, and charged at 44s per M.

The Department has ordered from the Company 12,200 more caps to enable you to complete your distribution list. They have been told that this is on account of their contract, and this quantity with the 3000 already ordered by you will make a total of 15,200 extra gun caps, for which they should send you their account at the contract rate. The voucher for the 3000 caps at 55¢ per N will be cancelled when the other one is received.

The clause in the contract will be found in the form of agreement following the index. I herewith enclose for your information a copy of the form with the clause underlined in red ink.
