Sir,

I have the honor to request that you will make the strongest possible effort, to make the Indians, on the Reserves under your care, support themselves entirely, for the space of one month, from say - the 1st day of October, without drawing upon the Department for any provisions. It is thought that this may be managed while they ^{yet} have produce from their farms in hand, and while game is plentiful.

In case you should find it impossible to fully, carry out this proposal, you will be good enough to reduce your issue of provisions to the lowest limit possible.
