STATEMENT OF SGT. MCCLOY, CONT'D.

Mrs BROWN lives at the Kingsway Hotel 66 Guilford St. Russell Sq. London, W.C.1. There are no children by my Common Law wife. The two mentioned in my paybook are hers by a former husband, by the name of ALLEN. This fact is also known in Ottawa, as their birth certificates were forwarded there.

When questioned concerning the blank pass which bore the unit orderly room stamp, McCloy stated that these were easily obtained as they were often kept in a small room in the billets where the passes were handed out to personnel going on leave. A close check of his person and property failed to locate any more of these blank passes, so it is presumed that he only took the one mentioned in his statement, which he subsequently destroyed.

3. It will be noted in previous report dated 29 Mar 43, submitted by Sgt. HOLME of this branch (para 2), that enquiries instigated by him established the fact that this soldier is in possession of funds from a family source which enables him to finance himself during his periods of absence without resorting to crime. There is no evidence available at this office which would suggest that McCloy has been implicated in anything of a criminal nature.

4. This soldier is being returned to his unit under escort in the a.m. of the 2 Nov 43.
