The accused, K55530 Pte. Erling FAGERVIK, 1st Bn., The Canadian Scottish Regiment, (AF), a soldier of the Canadian Army, placed on Active Service in England, is charged with:

First Charge

in the Field, at about 2100 hours, 20th July 1942, by discharging his rifle, wilfully injured himself by fracturing the bone of his left thigh just above the knee, with intent thereby to render himself unfit for service.
