On Dec 3rd 1944, at about 2230 A hrs.
Cpl Prefase, the guard commander
reported to the platoon orderly
room, that Pte Hancock and
some other men were missing
when tatoo roll call was
taken. After reporting to me
Cpl Prefase took the tatoo
roll call to Coy HQ. On all
reveille and tatoo roll calls
subsiquent to this time Pte.
Hancock remained to be
marked absent. I did not see
him again until the morning
5 Jan 1945.
Cpl Prefase also reported to
me that M/C CC 5262474 was
missing that night. I immediately
forwarded the report to Coy HQ.
