

- 3.6 TV Producers CO said survey did not generally favor changes at this period. Dir TV QUE to follow up.
- 3.7 Halifax TV Operations Report Report being assembled. AGM & CO to discuss distribution.
- 3.8 Overtime CA informs survey completed & ready next week. General Manager says overtime cost \$1,800,000 in 1956-1957. COMPT gives figures for April, May and June, 1957: \$527,000 (\$420,000 for TV).
- 3.9 Study of Salaries CO informs P&A still in process of gathering data throughout industry especially from Bell Telephone who surveyed 48 Canadian companies. General Manager meeting Bell representatives August 9th. Civil Service increases reviewed and comparisons made with CBC salaries. Hope expressed full report to MGMT within 10 days. AMA has available list of salaries in 3,000 companies in US and Canada, including US broadcasting organizations.
4. Internal Audit Office Treasury considering resident auditors and small staff in Montreal & Toronto. COMPT to take up with ONT and QUE matter of space accommodation.
5. TV Week & CBC-TV 5th Anniversary CB to follow up with ONT and QUE. Plans already well firmed up in Montreal and Toronto.
6. Personal Testimonials by CBC Employees This forbidden by CBC internal regulations. QUE to take immediate action.
7. Program Items
- 7.1 Royal Visit ACB informed tentative program drawn up & submitted to Prime Minister & Buckingham Palace. Ottawa has advised Prince Philip did not wish to speak or broadcast. Government Hospitality Committee meeting shortly. At request of Secretary of State, Parliament building surveyed in view of overflow of guests. CO informed estimating going forward on revised plans. G. Arthur informed IS planning to do live broadcast of all main events.
- 7.2. Football CB informed WIFU arrangements completed. Contract with Dow being drawn up and Molson contract studied. General Motors will not co-sponsor but Molson under contract to fulfill. Blackout clause in contract & COM exploring possibility of substituting another game to game played in city where blackout effective.
- 7.3 Radisson DTV QUE informed production going ahead & budgeting under \$1,000,000. Planned to schedule Sept. 2nd.
- 7.4 NFB Films CB informed agreement reached on price: 26 half-hour episodes of Perspective & 26 Passage partout to cost \$7,000 each (\$5,000 last year); 9 half-hours in English and 9 in French of World in Action

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
