Mr.Gillett explained the attitude
of the Department in this question, and explained that it was the
wish of the Dept. that the Council of Hartley Bay should carry
on as in previous years, until such a time when, by an 'Order in Coun
Council', the village should be definitely placed under the
Advancement Section of the Indian Act.

At I2 o'clock the meeting adjourned, to meet again at I p.m.

Jan. 8, 1942, I p.m.

The question of the validity of the existing bylaws was discussed, and these bylaws were re-arranged by the Indian Agent. A new copy of such bylaws was to be made and same to be endorsed by the Indian Agent.

Mr.Gillett speke of the fine work done by the retiring Council during its term of office. A motion of thanks for the fathful work done by the retiring Council was offered by Mr.J.Pahl and seconded by Mr.Geo.Clifton. The motion was unanimously approved.
