Fredericton a Divisional Point.

The St. John Valley Railway, the largest of those under construction, will have the greatest bearing on the advancement of Fredericton. This line is now being built from Grand Falls to St. John, and involves an expenditure of many millions of dollars, besides opening up one of the richest agricultural and fruit-raising districts in Canada. Fredericton has been made a divisional point, and it is here that the car and machine shops of this new route will be established.

Announcement has been made that a branch line will be constructed from Napudogan, a divisional point on the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway, to Fredericton, and it is also only a question of time when this city will be on a through trunk line running from Quebec City to Halifax.
