conclusion, call the attention of my young readers to this most interest-

ing point.

Oh! that they would, like Benjamin, fix heart and soul upon religion, the most sacred object of their love and veneration! The practice of virtue, simplicity of heart, the correction of one's own faults, and the acquiring of all those precious virtues which endears man to God, in short all those delights and consolations which God, in is goodness, has left to mankind even in the lowest grades of society; all these are surely as deserving of the student's attention as the mere booklearning for which he goes to school. Let them no longer draw a line of distinction between the desire of acquiring knowledge and the improve-
