

Art. 3. When a member is on the sick-list he shall not frequent gambling-houses or saloons, nor become intoxicated, under a penalty of forfeiture of sick pay and a fine of five dollars for first offence. If the offence is repeated he shall be expelled from the Lodge.

Art. 4. No member receiving the sick benefits of this Lodge shall be out before 7 a.m. and not later than 8 p.m. from the first of May to the first of October, or before 9 a.m. or not later than 5 p.m. from the first of October to the first of May, unless by the consent of the Lodge physician; and all members, to receive full sick benefits, must take the four fundamental degrees, or they can only demand two-thirds benefits for sickness.

Art. 5. The funeral benefits of this Lodge are seventy-five dollars on the death of a member, and twenty dollars on the death of a member's wife. \$37.00 of the sum of \$75.00 payable on the death of a member is to be taken from the general fund of this Lodge, the balance as provided for in Section F, Art. 2, Constitution.

Art. 6. The physician shall be paid quarterly at the rate of \$3.00 per annum for all members good on the books at the end of the quarter.

Art. 7. The Corresponding Secretary shall be paid quarterly at the rate of 25 cents per member per annum.
