neglect to perform such military duty, as shall be required from be required, or him, or shall depart from his colours or guard without leave from the commanding officer, shall forfeit twenty shillings; and for non-payment thereof, shall be committed by warrant from the commanding officer then present to the next goal, till the faid twenty skillings be paid, with the prison charges; and the fine and charges sheriff of such county and city, is hereby required to receive the body or bodies of such offender or offenders against this act, as shall be brought to him by virtue of a warrant or warrants under the hand and feal of fuch officer as aforefaid, and him or them to keep in fafe custody, until such sees and fines mentioned in such warrant are paid. And such sheriff or keepers of goals the same sees as in shall be intitled to the same sees as are allowed in other cases, and the fines so recovered, shall be disposed of by the commanding officer, for the benefit of the company to which company, the offender doth belong.

And be it further enacted, That the several other fines, penalties and forfeitures in this act mentioned, shall be levied, lows, viz. recovered, and disposed of as followeth: - That is to fay, that all fuch forfeitures, as do relate to any person under the degree of a Captain, shall be adjudged by and be taken to the respective Captains, to defray the charges of their companies, and to be levied before the next exercifing day, by diffress and fale of the offenders goods by the Captains warrant, directed to a ferjeant, or corporal of the company wherein such offence was But if the offender be a fervant, or under his parents care, then in such case the masters or parents goods shall be liable to such distress and sale as aforesaid, till satisfaction be And if any serjeant or corporal shall refuse to execute fuch warrant to him directed, he shall for every such offence forfeit for the uses above-mentioned the sum of thirty shillings, to be levied in manner before expressed, by such other officer, ferieant, or corporal, as such warrant shall be directed to. for all other penalties and forfeitures in this act mentioned, the fame shall be levied by distress and sale of the offenders goods by warrant, from the Colonel, or the next field-officer where fuch offenders are; which forfeiture and penalty shall be for mall before the use the use and benefit of the regiment or battalion in the city, town, or county where the offence is committed; and the ferjeants and corporals of the regiment or battalion, are to referve possible referees to themselves, out of the distress or sorfeiture, the sum of three executing each ficillings,
