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BOERS PASS WAR LAW

Gold Mines May Be Confiscated if Owners Are Traitors.

GERMANY HAS WARNED KRUGER

Ministers Are Busy in London-Lord Wolsey at the War Office-Mr. Conyngham Greaves Afloat of Dynamite-Long Despatches Sent to Lord Curzon and Sir Alfred Milner.

Pretoria, Sept. 19.—The Volksraad yesterday re-adopted the mining article in the gold law, eliminated last year, empowering the Government to work them through its own agents. The re-adopted article comes into force immediately.

The Transvaal State Secretary, Mr. F. W. Retz, in the course of an interview yesterday, declared that the Government, the Volksraad and the people were unanimous regarding the attitude which the Transvaal has assumed and that there was no foundation for the reports of differences. Mr. Retz also asserted that the Transvaal's declaration of war with Great Britain, and that the German consuls in the Transvaal have been instructed to inform Germans who volunteer their help that they will be aiding President Kruger at their own risk.

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
