A despatch dated Constantinople, Oct. 10th, evening, says:—At a sitting of the Extraordinary Council today it was decided that the Russian army should not move.

The decision and its conditions will be communicated to the European powers tomorrow.

The Times London editorial says:—It is true that an armistice has been granted, there is still good hope for peace, and Turkey has placed herself in a position to reject the armistice she would forfeit all claim to consideration.

The entire business portion of Sandy Hook, N. J., was burned last night. Loss, over two hundred thousand dollars.

A decree has been issued in France summing the Senate and Deputies to assemble on the 20th October.

The following are given as conditions on which the Porte consents an armistice:—Russia must stop the march of troops to Serbia and Bulgaria; Serbia must immediately suspend hostilities and give military guarantees; Turkey should accept the armistice.

# BY-LAW.

To establish additional Polling Places in several of the Parishes in the Municipality of York for the election of Councilors and for holding proceedings thereat.

It is ordained by the County Council of York:—

1. That by authority of an Act passed by the Legislature in session of A. D. 1875, entitled "An Act to authorize the County Council of the several municipalities in the Province of New Brunswick, to establish additional Polling places in the several Parishes in their respective municipalities for the election of County Councilors, and to make by-laws in relation thereto." Additional Polling places for the election of Councilors be and the same are hereby established at the places hereinafter named, in the undermentioned Parishes, subject to the provisions of the above recited Act, as follows:—

In the Parish of Saint Mary's, at or near Gibson Station, to be designated "No. 2 St. Mary's," said district to be bounded as in the Act establishing an additional Polling place for the election of members to serve in the General Assembly.

In the Parish of Canterbury, at or near High Meadows, to be designated "High Meadows," said district to be bounded as in the Act establishing an additional Polling place designated No. 3, for the election of members to serve in the General Assembly.

In the Parish of Hantsport, at or near Robert's Landing, to be designated "Robert's Landing," said district to be bounded as in the Act establishing an additional Polling place for the election of members to serve in the General Assembly.

In the Parish of Saint John's, at or near the School House, to be designated "School House," said district to be bounded as in the Act establishing an additional Polling place designated No. 4, for the election of members to serve in the General Assembly.

On the day of election of Councilors the electors present at each of the above named polling places shall elect a chairman who shall take the roll of the names of the electors present, and shall also act as a teller, and shall also act as a teller, and shall also act as a teller.

The meeting shall begin at ten o'clock in the morning, the voting shall be by ballot, the names of the candidates for Councilors shall be written on printed paper and put into a box by the electors, at one o'clock the polls in each additional polling place shall be closed, and the electors shall be called upon to carry the box and the list to the chairman of the meeting held in District No. 1, or by whatever name the district may be known, and shall deliver the box to the chairman, and shall also act as a teller.

Any person guilty of a breach of any of the provisions of this By-law shall be liable to a fine of not more than five pounds, and shall be subject to a penalty of two pounds to be paid for each offence.
