# Winter Butter.

A customer who uses Herbingeum for his mileh cows informs me that if at any time he quits feeding Herbingeum for a few days his wife draws his attention to the fact that there is a decrease in the quantity of milk and that it is of poorerquality. For hogs we find it profitable and assure one customers that if they will feed it regularly to their pigs they will be free from worms—one great trouble with hogs—and that will do better in every respect.

I find that when I feed Heringenm to my milch cows during the winter that the cream separates better from the milk, and the butter separates more quickly from the cream, and I can churn in at least one-third of the time.

During the autumn of 1891, when the pasture became dry and hard, Mr. Pynn, hotelkeeper here, began feeding his cow half a gallon of chop daily, which he continued all winter. After she was stabled a couple of weeks he decided to use Herpingenria during the winter, and within two weeks of commencing its use, there was a daily increase of two quaris of milh, which was continued to calving time, in March, and at a cost of only eight cents per week.






