

Winter Butter.

A customer who uses **Herbageum** for his milk cows informs me that if at any time he quits feeding **Herbageum** for a few days his wife draws his attention to the fact that there is a decrease in the quantity of milk and that it is of poorer quality. I find it improves the color and flavor of the butter, the difference being as great as there ordinarily is between that from an Ayrshire and that from a Jersey. I feed it when on the grass as well as when stabled.

During the autumn of 1891, when the pasture became dry and hard, Mr. Lynn, hotelkeeper here, began feeding his cow half a gallon of chop daily, which he continued all winter. After she was stabled a couple of weeks he decided to use **Herbageum** during the winter, and within two weeks of commencing its use, there was a daily increase of two quarts of milk, which was continued to calving time, in March, and at a cost of only eight cents per week.
