

TOAST WATER.—When you have toasted until brown about half a slice of a quarters wheat loaf, pour over it in a jar or jug about a quart of water. Let it stand an hour and a half, and pour the water clear from the toast into a wine decanter. If a flavour be desired, it can be added, to the taste of the individual.
