

How Canada's Government Honored the King's Memory

At the hour of the King's funeral the military forces of the Capital assembled on Parliament Hill, Ottawa, standing with arms reversed while the bands played Chopin's "Funeral March." For three minutes there was a dead silence, broken by the "Dead March in Saul." Many were moved to tears by the solemnity of the occasion.
