one woman at the AS-1 level retired. The fourth man(formerly an employee at the CR-4 level) won a competition in which there were 4 applicants (2 women, and 2 men). One woman was screened out leaving 1 woman and 2 men to be interviewed.

There were 4 competitions for positions at the AS-2 level; in three of them, there were no women applicants, in the fourth a woman at the CR-4 level won the competition.

There were 4 competitions for positions at the AS-3 level; in three of them, there were no women applicants, in the fourth there were 8 applicants (1 woman, 7 men). One woman and 2 men were qualified.

The increase in the participation rate of men at the AS-5 level reflects changes forecast last year, which were one of the results of the re-organization of the Bureau of Physical Resources.

There was 1 competition at the AS-6 level - 1 man (an employee at the EG-ESS-9 level) applied and was appointed.

There was 1 competition at the AS-7 level - 1 man (an employee at the AS-6 level) applied and was appointed.

All movements in the AS-5, 6, and 7levels took place in the Bureau of Physical Resources, which was undergoing a re-organization. As had been forecast last year, 5 male employees at the EG-ESS-8 level became AS-5s.

There was the following intake from the Administrative Support Category involving 8 men and 2 women:
