It is very difficult, if not impossible, for spouses to find paid work since it is Tunisian policy to give preference to Tunisian citizens. There are no longer openings for teachers in primary and secondary schools as Tunisia can now meet its own needs and even sends teachers to other countries. Wages are much lower than in Canada.

Canadians might find employment with international organizations such as WHO, the UN, CARE, HOPE, and the FAO but they must comply with Tunisian administrative formalities in order to work legally for such bodies.
