Working Holiday Program

WHAT IS IT?

This program allows students and non-students to expand their travel experience by living and working in Sweden.

How Long is it?

The working permit is valid for up to 12 months. Employment is not limited to only one employer, place or particular field. Working permits can only be issued from the Swedish Embassy in Ottawa or a Swedish Consulate in Canada.

Admission requirements

To be eligible, you must:

- be 18 to 30 years of age;
- possess a valid Canadian passport; and
- have an adequate knowledge of Swedish or English.

WHAT TO DO TO PARTICIPATE

Applications must be submitted in person at least six weeks before the intended date of arrival in Sweden.

You are responsible for making your own travel arrangements. If you are not covered by an international insurance plan for medical and hospital expenses, you must join a group insurance plan or take out individual insurance.
