The delegation will also include one officer from each of the Canadian missions in Karachi, New Delhi, and Colorbo.

The meeting of officials will open in New Delhi on September 28, and the Ministerial Meeting of the Corrittee will begin on October 13.

All members of the Consultative Cormittee are expected to attend the forthcoring reeting, including representatives of the Governments of Australia, Burna, Ceylon, Cambodia, Indonesia. Laos. Malaya, Nepal, New Zealand, Pakistan, the United Kingdor, the United States and Vietnam. Observers from Thailand, The Philippines, the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development, and the Economic Comission for Asia and the Far East have been invited to attend.
