Mr. White (Hastings) introduced a Bill No. 68 relating to interest on moneys secured by Mortgage on Real Estate; which was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading, to morrow.

The House resumed the adjourned Debate on Sir Leonard Tilley's proposed motion, that Mr. Speaker do now leave the Chair for The House to go into Committee on Ways and Means.

And The House having continued to sit after 12 of the clock, midnight;

And the Debate continuing;—the said Debate was, on motion of Mr. Farrow, adjourned.

A Message was received from the Senate with the following Bill No. 69 of their own, intituled: "An Act respecting "La Banque Ville-Marie," to which the concurrence of this House was desired.

On motion of Mr. Desjardins, the said Bill was read the first time, and ordered for a second reading, to-morrow

Also,—agreeing to the Bill No. 27 to amend the Act 43 Victoria, Chapter 61 intituled: "An Act to incorporate the Assiniboine Bridge Company," and to change the name of the said Company, without amendment.

The House then adjourned at 25 minutes past 12 o'clock, A.M.
