Same as in No. 3, down to the words "for ever"—then go on as follows:—to the uses and upon the trusts following, that is to say:—upon the trusts to hold the same forever hereafter as and for the place and site of a Church and church-yard, and burial-ground, for the sole use and benefit of members of the Church residing in the place adjacent to the said site and premises within the said Diocese of Quebec, according to the doctrine and discipline of the United Church of England and Ireland, and for no other purposes, and under the provisions of the aforesaid Act of Incorporation of the said Church Society.
