Pried Apples are quiet and stendy with sales of jobbing lots at 6\(\frac{1}{2}c\) to 7c. Cheese unchanged at 13c to 13\(\frac{1}{2}c\) for the best and 12c to 12\(\frac{1}{2}c\) for ordinary.
