

Mr. PUGSLEY. I move that this item of \$57,000 be reduced to \$37,000.

Motion agreed to.

Mr. EDWARDS. I beg to call the hon. gentleman's attention to the item of \$15,000 for a veterinary hospital which, I understand, was to be struck out.

Mr. PUGSLEY. I think that was struck out in the committee.

Mr. EDWARDS. It was voted in the committee and the minister said he would strike it out on concurrence.

Mr. PUGSLEY. I thank my hon. friend (Mr. Edwards) for calling my attention to it. My recollection was that it had been considered in committee and had been struck out. But I will move now that the item be struck out.

Motion agreed to, item as amended concurred in.

Public Works—Chargeable to income—Harbours and rivers—New Brunswick—Richibucto cape—Breakwater wharf, \$10,000.

Mr. PUGSLEY. I move that this item be reduced from \$10,000 to \$5,000. The reason is that \$5,000 is all we shall be able to spend to advantage this year.

Motion agreed to. Item as amended concurred in.

Department of Militia and Defence—Salaries, \$111,690.

Hon. Sir FREDERICK BORDEN (Minister of Militia and Defence). I move in amendment that the words be added 'including the salary of C. L. Panet, \$2,600.' There is no increase involved. The reason of the amendment is that the Auditor General will not pay the amount unless the name is mentioned. There is no provision under the new Civil Service law for private secretaries. This amount is precisely what has been paid, but it includes an amount of \$500 for private secretary. I want these words added so that the salary can be paid.

Amendment agreed to.

Trent canal—construction, \$1,000,000.

Mr. J. A. CURRIE moved that the item of \$1,000,000 for Trent canal construction be reduced by whatever amount is contained therein for expenditure upon the Newmarket canal.
