6th, In the morning Admiral Holmes made up with his fleet to St. Nicholas, six leagues above Quebec. *N.B.* This Morning the Rodney cutter sail'd express for England.

7th, Landed 2200 of the troops at St. Nicholas, on the south shore, in order to refresh them, being extremely crowded in the transports.

12th, Re-embark'd the troops from St. Nicholas, without the loss of a man; and as the inhabitants of St. Nicholas had not attempted to disturb our troops, either at landing or when on shore, their houses and effects were left untouch'd.—In the evening
