INTRODUCTION.

As the title page admits, this is a small compilation from larger works, having the same object in view, but which would have led new M. Ps. astray, if published in extenso. The information published in this pamphlet is not of a party nature, but will enable members, from all sections of the House, to take advantage of the Rules of Parliament, for the management of such business as they have in charge, and to move with greater freedom upon public as well as private matters of Legislation. It is not compiled with a view to profit, but simply with a desire to see every member au fait in the routine of the House, and thereby to avoid confusion. The Rules which govern the Assembly apply to the practice herein laid down, and it is utterly impossible for any member to avail himself of the one, without having an intimate knowledge of the other. With this Pamphlet, and the Rules and Orders of the House, any member can, in a short time, make himself completely at home in the routine and practice of Parliament.
