of this Association; this may be effectively done by disseminating the pamphlets of the Association, and more especially by urging on the members of the various Legislatures the vast importance of the desired changes being made at the next sessions of these bodies. The improvement of the law of real estate is essentially a question for the people. Everyone who has had transactions in land, is aware of the evil of the present system, and there is no doubt that as soon as there is a strong expression of public opinion in favour of the Torrens System it will be adopted.
