Delegates to Grand Lodge Are Having a Good Time, Combining Business and Pleasure.

Windsor, Ont., Aug. 15.—At 8 o'clock last evening the sons of England delegates boarded the cars of the S. W. & A. Railway for the guests of Prince of Wales Lodge.

The route was by the belt line to Walkerville, where a halt was made to visit the offices of Messrs. Walker and the home of Mr. Robins. The trip was continued west by the front route, and a start made for Orlawa. When the springs were reached a thunderstorm had reached its climax, and a deluge of rain fell. It was a very jolly outing, despite the storm. Mr. Robins' band accompanied the party. On the return it was not considered advisable to longer continue the trip.

The Grand Lodge resumed their regular business this morning in the auditorium of the Collegiate Institute. There were 125 in attendance. The lodge went into Committee of the Whole, with Mr. Parnell chairman. The session was taken up in considering the grand officers' reports. Proposed amendments to the constitution were discussed at length. The suggestion to widen the membership clause by admitting all white male British subjects of the Empire was voted down. A proposal of Kent Lodge, Toronto, permitting those born in Canada and New York and who had been members of the lodge to join, was also voted down. The session extended until 1 o'clock, when the Grand Lodge adjourned.

This afternoon Prince of Wales Lodge took the delegates to Star Island House at the St. Clair Hotel, where a complimentary dinner will be given to the guests. The tomorrow morning the business of the lodge will be continued.

BEHEADED BY A TRAIN.

Charles Geiger, a Painter of Rochester, Met With Instant Death at Lockport.

Lockport, N.Y., Aug. 15.—Charles Geiger of Rochester was instantly killed this morning. He was on a ladder painting a signal tower of the New York Central Railroad near West Gulf bridge. The engine of a passenger train passed the foot of the ladder, but a car struck him, throwing him under the wheels of the train. His head was cut off. Geiger was 35 and unmarried. The engineer thinks the jar of the train caused the ladder to slip.

Aldermen Who Are Short on Pledges Try to Place Ratepayers' Attention on the Engineer.

Whether the Woodbine-avenue "Y" is being used to the convenience or detriment of the public was the question upon which the Board of Control divided yesterday. Not only did the board divide, but its divided parts accused each other of motives and games worthy of the Heathen Chinee.

The Mayor's Resolution.

The Mayor came down to the board armed with the following type-written resolution:

"The City Solicitor having drawn the attention of the board to the fact that in the opinion of Mr. Fullerton, given in this matter, the Y connecting the tracks was to extend 600 feet south of Queen-street upon Woodbine-avenue, and that the Y as constructed is really north of Queen-street, and that he had inquired from the Engineer's office and was informed that no consent had been given to any Y upon Woodbine-avenue north of Queen-street, ordered that the City Solicitor be requested to notify the Toronto Railway Co. to take up the Y upon Woodbine-avenue north of Queen-street, and that it be removed from that date the same is not to be moved by the City Engineer in any way, and that the same be removed."

It appears that Engineer Rust had been asked to make a report upon the putting of the Y upon Woodbine-avenue north of Queen-street, and that he had refused to do so. The Mayor's resolution was passed by a vote of 10 to 5.
