a.m.—Prices rose again at the outset
of today's trading, with further confident
absorption and short covering of
the various issues embraced in the war

its recent record. Other equipments and munitions were 1 to 2 points up, Westinghouse showing marked activity. Shipbuilding advanced from $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 point, and Mexican Petroleum gained $\frac{1}{4}$. Automobile issues were the only heavy features. Recessions in General Motors.

land extended from 115 to almost 3 points. Rails and coppers were slightly irregular.

Noon—in its chief essentials the market followed the course of recent days. Extensive profit-taking and heaviness of a specialties provoked reaction.

Afternoon, when specialties manifested further irregularities. Shipings and motors were under pressure and United States Steel reacted sharply with rails. Industrial Alcohol was active, with a point advance.
