Realizing Sales Usher in Moderate Reaction, But Sentiment Continues Bullish—Liverpool Cables Steady.

World Office. Wednesday Evening, Sept. 22. Liverpool wheat futures closed 4-1/2 day bid lower to 5-1/2 higher than yesterday.

Chicago Sept. wheat closed 1-1/2 day bid lower than yesterday. Sept. corn 1-1/2 day bid lower than yesterday. October wheat unchanged.

Chicago car lots to-day: Wheat 24, contract 1 corn 25, 184, and oats 104, 34. Winnipeg car lots of wheat to-day 94, this day last year 86, oats 47, 37.

ST. LAWRENCE MARKET. Receipts of farm produce were 70 bushels of apples, 10 loads of hay, with many loads of mixed produce, the bulk being composed of apples and potatoes.

Wheat—One hundred bushels sold at 85c. Oats—Four hundred bushels sold at 45c to 46c.

Hay—Thirty loads sold at 35c to 37c per ton. Straw—One load of loose sold at 49 per ton.

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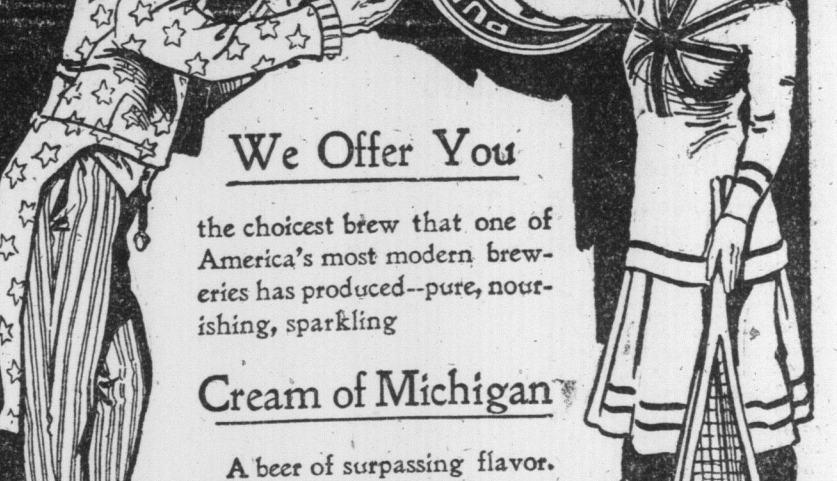
